**Luke 5:16: “Jesus often withdrew to the wilderness to pray.”**

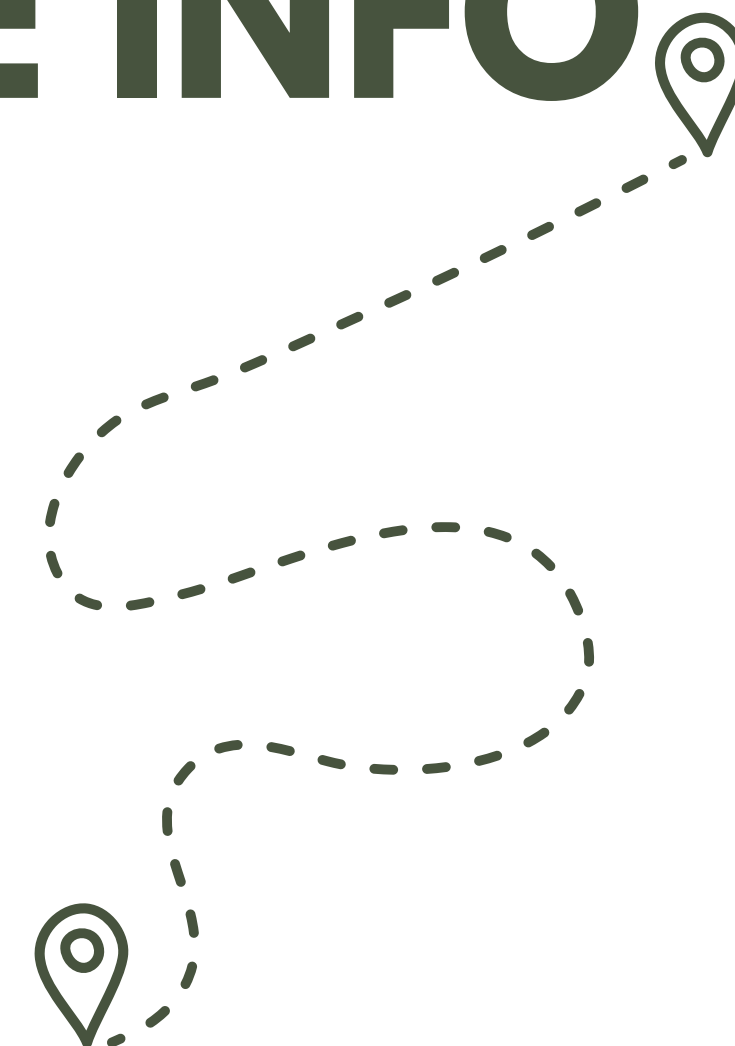

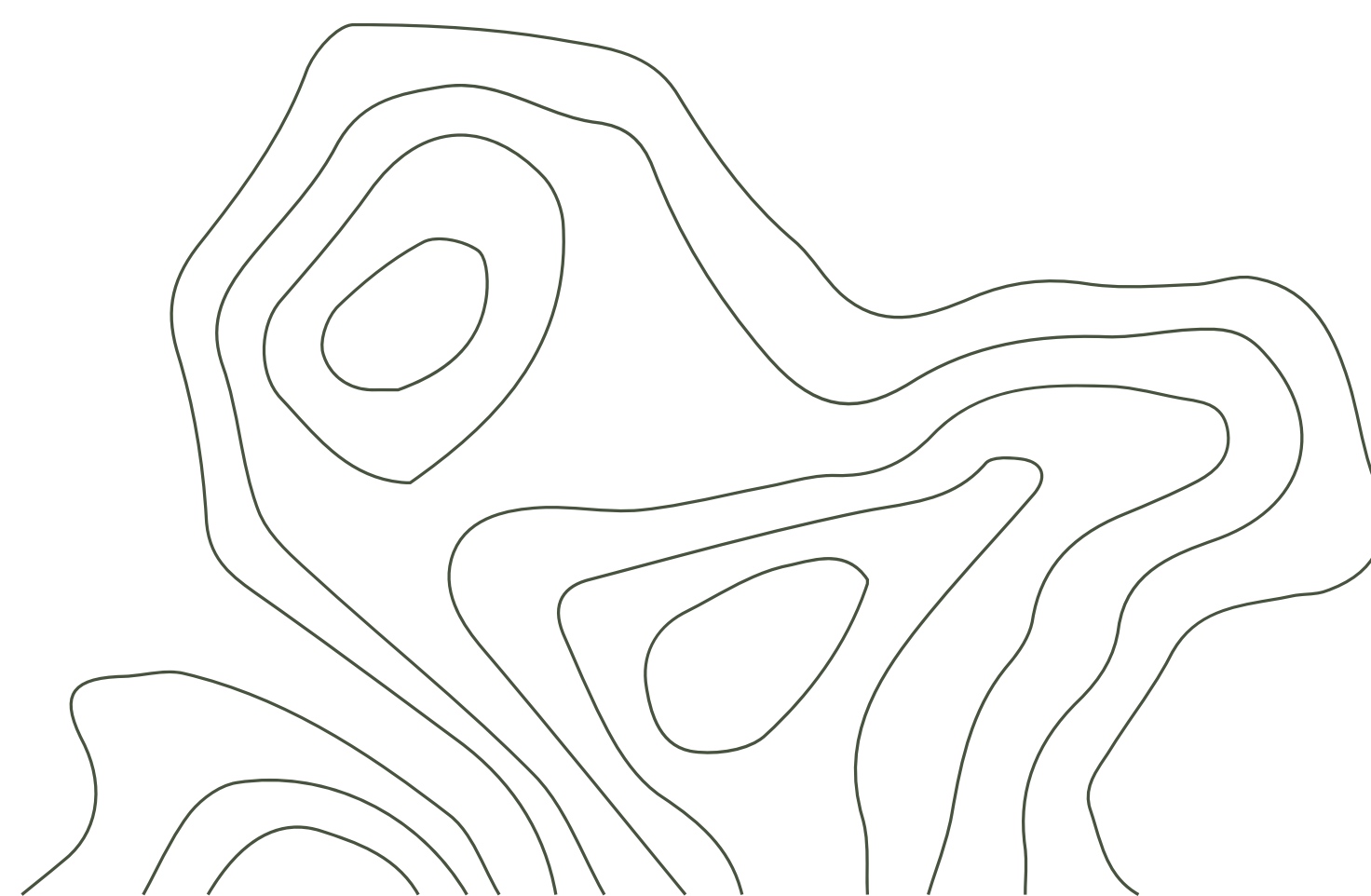

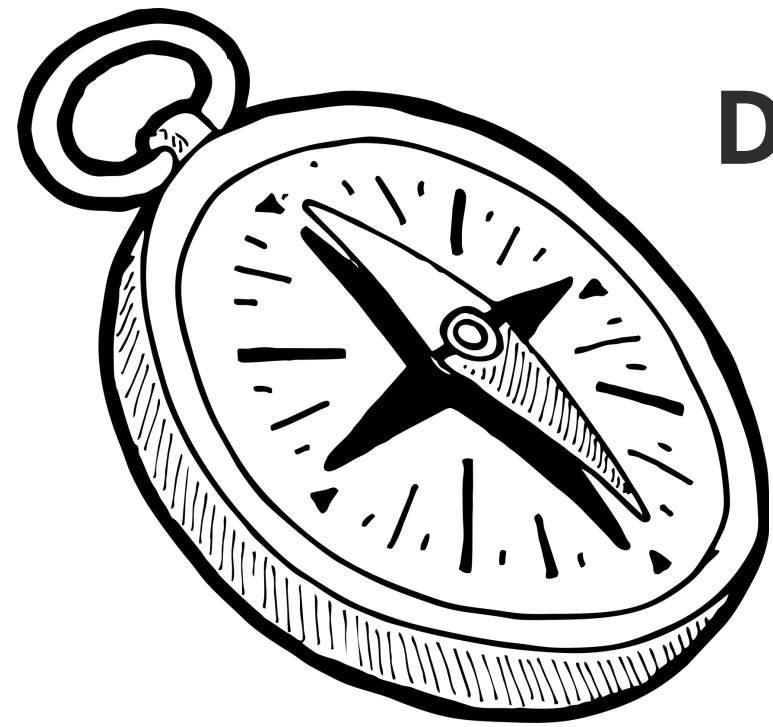
# Discipline Policy
